Woodlands had two teams represented at the TBAWA Warren Lake Carnival on Sunday 5 December 2021 at Yokine Reserve. The under 9 team, Gobsmacked Goblins coached by Tim Boekhoorn came third and the under 11 team Doubleview Diamonds coached by David McLean also came third. Well done to both teams.



The Woodlands Under 11 team Cool Cats played in the Natasha Bakranich All Girls Tee-Ball Carnival and came first in the under 12 division. The Cool Cats also took out the Under 11 A Girls Division and the Grand Final. Most of the girls played their last game of Teeball and a number of the girls will be moving onto softball next season.



Six of our Woodlands players represented the Wembley Teeball Assoc in the TBAWA State Championships held over the long weekend at Langley Park. The team have been training since January and participated in 2 Pre-State Carnivals. With the new Covid restrictions, TBAWA had to jump a few hoops to complete all the requirements to play. A big thank must go out to TBAWA for making sure that our players had the chance to play.

The team had 5 great games, there were 45 catches, 31 outs on base, 2 double plays, the players crossed home plate 72 times and there were 6 homes runs. This is quite an achievement considering the team play against the top metro and country teams in the Under 12 A grade.

In the Wembley team, we also had 2 Woodlands players who were selected to play in the TBAWA Super Squad teams. The teams play exhibition games at Pre-State Carnivals, the Warren Lake Carnival and the TBAWA States Champs Presentations. Well done to Oliver and Tyler from AR Advisors.



Round 3 commenced and finished so quickly. Unfortunately, due to further Covid restrictions, the Club were not able to host the yearly presentations and BBQ, even the format of the AGM had to be changed.
