#### **CLEANING CHECKLIST**

## Teams playing at 8.30 am

- The home team is responsible for cleaning the bases, shelters, benches and bat stands prior to the commencement of the game;
- Each team is responsible for cleaning the equipment in their own kit bag including helmets, chest plates, bat handles and the game ball;
- Each team will be responsible for cleaning the shelters, benches and bat stand at the conclusion of the game.

Teams playing at 8.30 am who do not have a game after them, are to return the equipment to the storage shed.

## Teams playing at 10.15 am

- Equipment should be cleaned from the earlier game but teams may wish to clean the shelters, benches and bat stand prior to the commencement of their game;
- Each team is responsible for cleaning the equipment in their own kit bag including helmets;
- Each team is responsible for cleaning the shelters, benches and bat stand at the conclusion of the game and return all the equipment to the storage shed;
- The home team is responsible for the cleaning of the bases prior to returning to storage.

- No parents, spectators or siblings in the team shelter.
- Parents and spectators must sit behind the foul line between the shelter and base.
- Parents and spectators must stay out of the area between the team shelter and the scorers.
- Parents must look after siblings.
- Parents to abide by Covid 19 1.5m distancing regulations.
- No food for players during the game unless a medical condition.
- Players must have their own water bottle and glove.
- Umpire to clean game ball before commencement of the game.
- Base coaches are not to touch players unless accident.
- No dogs in the players shelter or tied to the shelter and must be on a leash and controlled.
