Nine of our Woodlands players represented the Wembley Teeball Assoc in the TBAWA State Championships held over the long weekend at Yokine Reserve.

The Wembley team trained since January and participated in 2 Pre-State Carnivals. As there were no Covid Restrictions, there were many spectators including grandparents, past players and their families and lots of friends.

The team had 5 great games, there were 51 catches, 31 outs on base, 2 double plays and the players crossed home plate 61 times. This is quite an achievement considering the
