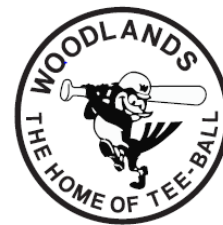

FIXTURES

Fixtures are drafted by the Wembley Teeball Assoc.

Under 7s and 9's play at 8.30am and under 11's play at 10.15am. Games are approximately 1 hour.

Round 1 – Saturday 14 October 2023 to Saturday 11 November 2023.

Round 2 – Saturday 18 November 2023 to Saturday 9 December 2023

On Saturday 25 November 2023, the under 9s and under 11s will play a double header. There will be two 45 minute games back to back with a 15 minute break between games so teams can change diamonds.

Round 3 – Saturday 3 February 2024 – Saturday 24 February 2024.

Due to the heat in Round 3, the times of the games will change to:

Under 7s and 9's play at 8.00am and under 11's play at 9.45am

Round 3 Double Header Games times will be 8.00 am and 9.00 am. Again there will be two 45 minute back to back games with a 15 minute break.

EQUIPMENT

Your coach will be given a kit bag with all the equipment required for training and games. Any equipment that is broken can be exchanged by contacting Ash Brewis. Players will need to have their own glove, all other essentials such as bats, uniforms and hats are provided by the club.

UNIFORMS

Your team manager will hand out uniforms at training. Team hats will stay with the manager and be handed out prior to the game and then returned to the manager for safe keeping. The manager will launder regularly. Appropriate footwear such as sports shoes must be worn at training and games.

MOUTHGUARDS

The club recommends that players wear mouthguards for training and games.

CHIEF UMPIRE'S REPORT

The role of team umpire can be quite rewarding and you have the best seat in the house! It only requires one hour of your time on a Saturday morning. Typically you will umpire one week at home plate and the next in the field. All umpires work as a team during the game. Formal training and accreditation is run by TBAWA but please notify our Chief Umpire Tim if you would like to attend the clinics. The costs of the clinics are invoiced to the club. Dates and venues are listed below. Tim is available to help any new or existing umpires to ensure it is enjoyable for you.

CHIEF COACH'S REPORT

Coaching can be a fun and a rewarding experience. If you are new to coaching, there is assistance from the club. For new coaches there is an information session on Wednesday 11 November 2023 from 7pm in the Warren Lake Hall at Woodlands Reserve.

TBAWA Coaching Clinics are conducted at the beginning of the season. These will assist you with training and games. (There is no cost to participants). Registrations are on line via the TBAWA website. Once you have registered, you will be required to view a PowerPoint presentation and complete a small quiz prior to attending the clinic. TBAWA WARREN LAKE CARNIVAL (YOKINE) – Sunday 3 December 2023

This is a great opportunity for the older age groups to experience playing other metropolitan teams in a carnival atmosphere. Teams will need to be your Saturday morning team. Woodlands Tee-Ball requires any volunteer over the age of 18 working with children and has no children playing in the club will be required to apply for a Working with Children Check.
